## Under this agreement for 2018

### Wallumbilla State School will receive

**\$57,088\***

#### This funding will be used to

- 100% students in P-2 will have speech screening, intervention and review by a Speech Language Therapist.
- 100% students in P-6 will be tracked using the Literacy Continuum to target specific student strengths and areas for further development by the end of 2018.
- 100% students will have opportunity to access targeted learning programs online as a result of ICT network upgrades and improvements in internet access.
- 100% students will be prioritised through a Student Support Committee to identify learning needs in areas of student support, at risk students and gifted and talented groups.

#### Our initiatives include

- Speech Language Therapist to deliver weekly speech language programming and provide professional learning for staff in speech language and oral language development to assist in the development of reading competence.
- Access Regional Pedagogy Coach to upskill teachers in the Early Start and Literacy Continuum in OneSchool.
- Formalise the Student Support Committee process and develop specific support programs for students.
- Allocate extra teacher non-contact time (NCT) in Junior Secondary to enable the development of targeted support programs including enhancement of Individual Curriculum Plans (ICPs) to improve student academic performance.
- Engage additional Teacher Aides in the P-6 Literacy Blocks to enhance targeted interventions for reading development.

Employ a Speech Language Therapist to service the school weekly	\$14,000
Employ additional teacher FTE to increase NCT time for staff to provide target support for students in Junior Secondary	\$13,000
Employ additional Teacher Aides to provide targeted support for students on specific programs from P-10	\$ 6,000
Engage in Wireless Upgrade Project to increase access to targeted programs online (ie. Maths Online, IMPACT Projects, EdStudio)	\$20,000
TRS to release teachers to be upskilled by Regional Pedagogy Coach in Early Start and Literacy Continuum	\$4,088
